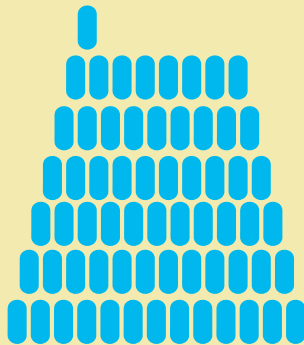

UNEQUAL ACCES TO PrEP, A DAILY PILL TO PREVENT HIV, PUTS **LATINOS** AT HIGHER RISK (2019)

CANNOT TRANSMIT HIV TO SEXUAL PARTNERS (2019)

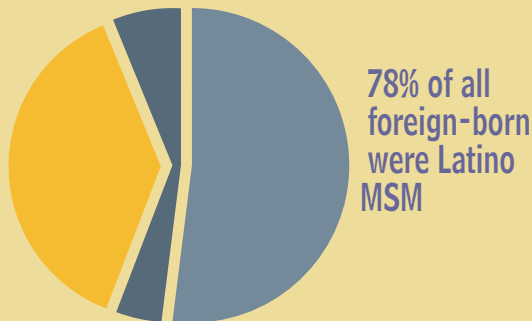
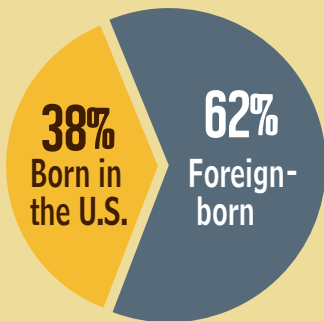


LATINO MEN ACCOUNT FOR **9** OUT OF **10**
